

Leave Manurewa Botanic Gardens car park and reset odometer as you turn left onto Hill Road. Continue through traffic lights to roundabout.

Take 2nd exit to STRATFORD ROAD

At roundabout, take 2nd exit into ALFRISTON ROAD

At roundabout, take 2nd exit to continue with ALFRISTON ROAD (school is on your right)

Continue straight ahead onto BROOKBY ROAD (Alfriston Road becomes Brookby Road at intersection with Alfriston-Ardmore Road on your right).

9.3 km (**5.8 miles**), turn right onto WEST ROAD

13.5 km (**8.4 miles**), at **T** turn left onto CLEVEDON ROAD

14.6 km (**9.1 miles**), sharp right onto MONUMENT ROAD

15.8 km (**9.8 miles**), right into Gate 6 Clevedon Showgrounds for Clevedon Farmers Market.

Turn right out of market and reset your odometer.

5.7 km (**3.5 miles**), MONUMENT ROAD becomes SKYHIGH ROAD continue straight ahead (MacGregor Road is on your right)

8.7 km (**5.4 miles**), left into WHITE ROAD. Immediately on right is the entrance to JOHN HILL ESTATE WINERY

Leaving John Hill Winery, turn left out of gate then immediately left onto JOHN HILL ROAD (9.2 km/5.7 miles)

10.4 km (6.4 miles), veer right into GARVIE ROAD

12.0 km (7.4 miles), turn left onto JONES ROAD

12.6 km (7.8 miles), turn right into Martyn and Jenny Ellwood-Wade's drive: 306 Jones Road "Cuesta Alpacas"

There will be a demonstration of a complex loom that Jenny uses to transform the alpaca fibre into fabric for clothing and other products. There will be an opportunity to purchase some alpaca merchandise.

Homeward Bound:

Leaving 306 Jones Road, Cuesta Alpacas:

Turn right onto Jones Road

At T junction at Hunua Road, there are **two options:**

1) Short route home:

Turn **right** for Papakura. Follow Hunua Road to the end and veer left onto Settlement Road. Go through the roundabout and over the rail bridge. Cross over Great South Road into Beach Road and then join SH1 as directed.

2) Long route home:

Turn left for Clevedon. Follow Hunua Road to John Hill Road and backtrack this morning's route to Clevedon. You might like to then go home via the coastal route to Maraetai.
